Beyond Hearing Aids

Are you a candidate for a cochlear implant?

Some hearing aid wearers may be a cochlear implant candidate if any of the following apply:

“I still **cannot follow most telephone conversations**, especially if I don't know the person calling.”

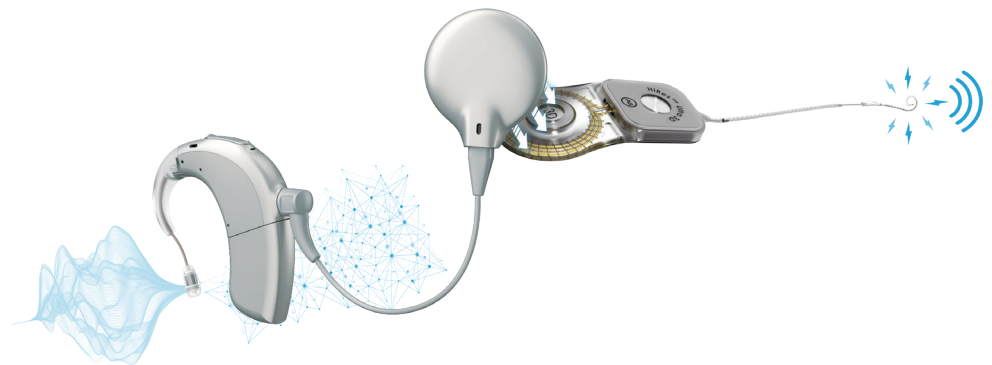
“I hear pretty well in quiet environments, but still **struggle in noisy environments** or when in a group.”

“I still have **difficulty following conversations** without lip reading.”

“My hearing loss makes me feel **socially isolated** and **occupationally limited**.”

What is a cochlear implant and how does it work?

If hearing aids are no longer meeting your needs, you may require a more advanced solution. A cochlear implant bypasses the cochlea—restoring hearing by sending sound directly to the hearing nerve.
